- The competition is open to students of both primary and upper sections.
- A contestant can submit maximum 2 entries under the relevant category.
- All the creations should be in either Sinhala or English.
- Your entries must be your own creations.

Primary Section (Grade 3-5)

Theme : *“Let’s protect wildlife and nature”*

- Artwork (size - A3/A4)
- Essay writing (word count - 50-70)
- Poetry (1-2 stanzas)

Upper Section

Category 1:- Grade 6-8

Theme: *“Wildlife is mother nature’s greatest treasure, to protect it,
let’s take every measure”*

- Artwork (size - A3/A4)
- Essay writing (word count – not less than 150)
- Poetry (3-4 stanzas)

Category 2:- Grade 9-11

Theme: “*When humans are restricted to the outer world how wild animals enjoy their freedom*”

- Artwork (size - A3/A4)
- Short video (time duration – less than 3 minutes) – Any video-making app can be used.
- Essay writing (word count – not less than 250)

Category 3:- Grade 12-13

Theme: *Should we cherish the wildlife by means of conservation or leave it to perish in the name of development?*”

- Graphic designing (posters, brochures, leaflets, collage) - Any graphic designing app can be used.
- Essay writing (word count – not less than 350)
- Poetry (4-6 stanzas)

- **1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners will be selected from each category of each competition.**
- **All the winners will be awarded with a valuable certificate.**
